

## REQUEST FOR ALTERNATE LEADSPERSON FORM

Holstein Association USA will provide a copy of the request to show management and retain a copy on file. Request must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. the day before the show or the animal is ineligible to show.

To be eligible to compete at National & Regional Junior Holstein Shows, entries must be shown by the Junior owner(s) in all cases, except by prior written approval. An Alternate Leadsperson form must be submitted to the Holstein Youth Specialist by 5:00 p.m. the day before the show. If approved, another National Junior Holstein member the same age or younger must exhibit the animal.
